
Zeus

Odysseus Special Power: Resourcefulness. Physical Attributes: traveller's hat. Character Traits: inventive, smart, cunning, loyal. Appearance: ragged, handsome, bearded.

Special Power: Strategic thinking.
Physical Attributes: wool, crown.
Character Traits: wise, helpful.
Appearance: beautiful, young.
