

Classics Faculty Teaching in Michaelmas Term

In accordance with University, and indeed Government, policy, Classics will follow a 'blended learning' approach during Michaelmas term.

All Prelim, Part 1A and Part 1B lectures will be online. Some will be recorded and made available on Moodle in advance, some will be live-streamed and uploaded to Moodle after the lecture, and where they are made available in advance some live Q & A sessions will be scheduled. All details will be given on the Moodle site for each course.

Most language classes at any level, and most Part II courses (those where numbers permit) will happen in person provided that those teaching the classes consider that it is safe for them to teach in person. Details of Part II class provision will be announced on the relevant Moodle site. Students due to attend language classes will be told when and where their class is happening.
