Sport Relief – BAY B



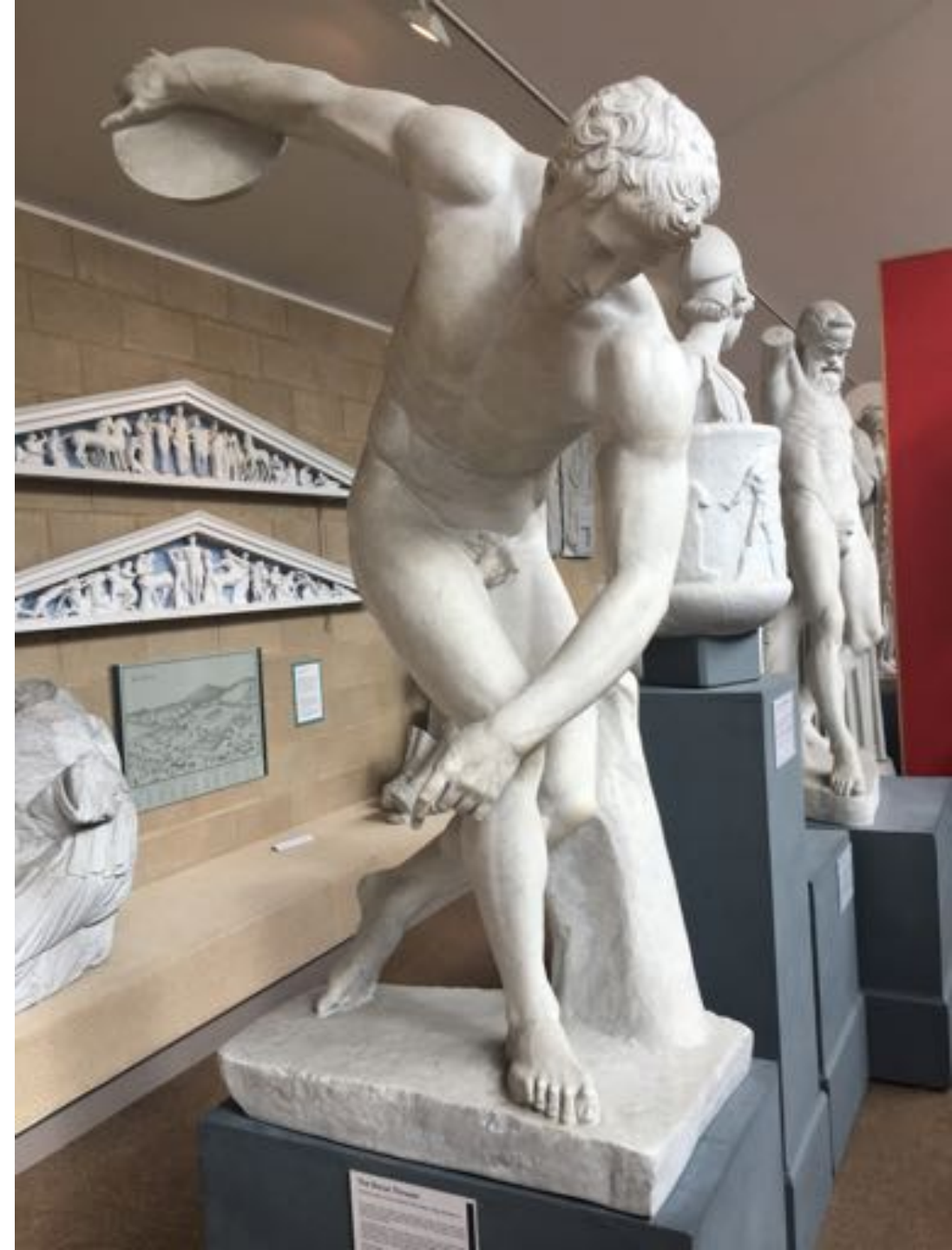






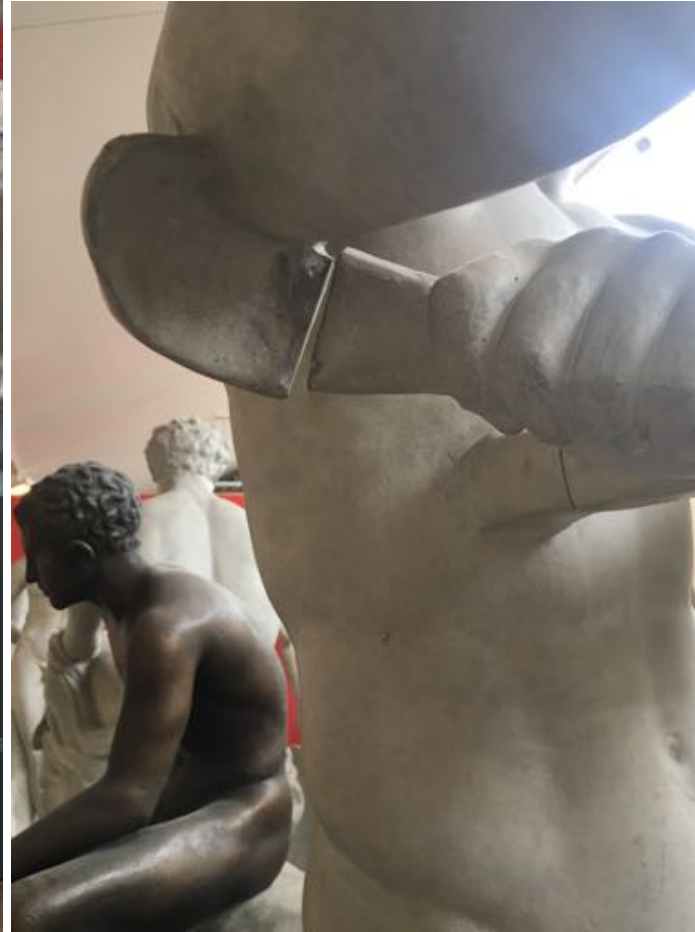
BAY C Athlete
