Getting to Know Things

In this first lesson, we will see:

1. Greetings: How the Romans greeted each other in Latin.
2. Numerals: How to say and write numbers in Latin.
3. Etymology: How some English words come from Latin words.

Lesson Plan for Parents:

1. Play the video lesson.
2. Play the "Greetings" PowerPoint.
3. Work through the "Greetings" worksheet.
4. Work through the "numbers" presentation and exercises
5. Play the etymology match-up activities and wordsearch.

The video can be played in parts, working through each topic at a time, or played in full before working through the exercises and games.

The topics are ordered by difficulty, so if the children are struggling with the earlier exercises, perhaps replay the earlier presentations and exercises and save the last exercises for a later date after some practice.

This week's programme does not need to be completed in one session.
